STATUS OF SMART CITIES MISSION

NO. 1983. SHRI SUSHIL KUMAR MODI:

Will the Minister of *Housing and Urban Affairs* be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of cities shortlisted under the Smart Cities Mission, State-wise details thereof;
- (b) the total amount of funds proposed to be provided to States under the Mission and amount of funds disbursed, State-wise details thereof;
- (c) the cities where Mission has been completed and the cities where 50 per cent and above work has been completed;
- (d) the quantum of funds provided to the cities in Bihar, the details of physical and financial progress made in this regard, city-wise; and
- (e) the actual timeline of the Mission and the revised timeline to which it has been further extended?

(a): Government of India launched Smart Cities Mission (SCM) on 25 June 2015. 100 Smart Cities as listed in **Annexure-I** have been selected through 4 rounds of competition from January 2016 to June 2018.

(b): As per SCM Guidelines, Central Government will provide financial support to the extent of ₹ 48,000 crore over five years i.e., on an average ₹ 100 crore per city per year. An equal amount on a matching basis will be contributed by the State Government/Urban Local Body (ULB). As on 4 March 2022, Government of India has released ₹ 29,213.60 crore for 100 Smart Cities, out of which ₹ 25,177.65 crore (86%) has been utilized. State/City-wise details of funds released by Government of India and utilization thereof by the Smart Cities is given in **Annexure-II**.

(c): As on 4 March, 2022, the Smart Cities have tendered out 6,928 projects worth ₹ 1,91,238 crore; work orders have been issued in 6,282 projects worth ₹ 1,65,503 crore; 3,576 projects worth ₹ 59,958 crore have been completed. So far, 40 Smart Cities have utilized more than 50% of proposed allocation of funds under SCM.

(d): Smart City-wise details of funds released by the Government of India under SCM to the State of Bihar, utilization thereof and the status of projects of these Smart Cities is given below:-

(e): SCM was launched as a Centrally Sponsored Scheme on 25 June 2015 for a period of five years. 100 Smart Cities were selected in various rounds i.e. (Round-1 in January 2016, Round-2 in May and September 2016, Round-3 in June 2017 and Round-4 in January 2018 and June 2018). The period of implementation of SCM has been extended upto June 2023 and all Smart Cities are expected to complete their projects within the stipulated time.
