POOR ROAD CONDITIONS IN ASSAM

1678. SHRI KAMAKHYA PRASAD TASA:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the four lanes of Assam are in very dilapidated condition and they are not fit for travel;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the steps being taken by Government for an immediate repair; and
- (c) by when the pitiable condition of an extended four-lane road on both sides of Brahmaputra would be completed?

ANSWER

- (a) and (b) Development & maintenance of National Highways in the country is the responsibility of the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways and is carried out through agencies such as National Highways Authority of India(NHAI), National Highways & Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd (NHIDCL), Border Road Organization (BRO) and State Governments/Union Territories through their Public Works Department/Road Construction Department etc. with whom such NHs are entrusted. All the National Highways under NHAI in Assam are in traffic worthy condition except the section from Jatinga to Harangajao. The maintenance of this section is also being carried out. There is only 12 km length of 4 Lane NH with State PWD and the same is in good condition. For the National Highways entrusted to NHIDCL, 10.08 km has been completed and in length of 502 km, work is in progress. These stretches of NHs are being maintained in motorable condition by EPC contractor as per the provisions of the EPC Contract Agreement.
- (c) Expected date of completion of 4- lane projects on both sides of Brahmaputra is enclosed as Annexure-1.
