**Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:**

- (a) The number of skill development institutes being run by public and private sector in the country at present and the number of youth being trained in these institutes; and
- (b) The steps taken by Government to provide employment to them after the training and the number of youth who have been given employment under this scheme till now?

(a) Under Skill India Mission, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) has been delivering skills through a comprehensive network of skill development centres/institutes under various schemes viz. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Jan Sikhshan Sansthan (JSS), National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) and Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs), to youths across the country. The details of skill development institutes being run by public and private sector in the country under PMKVY (including PMKK centres) are placed at **Annexure I**. The details of centres under JSS, NAPS and ITIs are placed at **Annexure II**.

Number of persons trained under the various schemes being implemented by MSDE under the Skill India Mission is as follows:

Apart from MSDE, more than 222 lakh youth have been trained by other Central Ministries through respective training centres as engaged by them.

(b) Government has taken various steps for generating employment in the country. Under PMKVY 2.0 scheme of MSDE, training Centres take all efforts to facilitate placements of certified candidates through multiple initiatives like RojgaarMela, Yuva Sampark and Aatmanirbhar Skilled Employees Employer Mapping (ASEEM) portal, collaboration with industries and Council. Under present phase of the PMKVY i.e PMKVY 3.0, demand driven and bottom-up approach has been provisioned to boost demand for job roles which are prevailing at regional/local level. In addition, informed choices/aspirations of the candidates have been given primacy which aims to support the self-employment as well. This scheme also supports the vision of Atmanirbhar Bharat by encouraging candidates to opt for local skill with local jobs.

23.7 lakh candidates have been provided employment under PMKVY since 2015. 1.02 lakh candidates have got self-employment/wage employment under JSS from 2018-19 to 31.12.2021. Since NAPS is an apprenticeship related scheme, no placement is tracked. As per tracer study, 63.5% to total ITI pass out are self/wage employed.
