FINANCIAL INCENTIVISATION POLICY TO BOOST MSMEs

2016. SHRI KAPIL SIBAL:
SHRI G.C. CHANDRASHEKHAR:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) registered and the number of those shut down, annually from 2016 till date;
- (b) whether Government has framed an enhanced financial incentivization policy to boost the MSMEs sector;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and, if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) the number of MSMEs currently functioning, and the number of those currently lying closed, by State/UT; and
- (e) whether Government plans on providing employment, subsidies and financial compensation to persons affected by the closure of MSMEs due to the COVID-19 pandemic?

ANSWER

(a): The total number of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) registered and shut down as per Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum (UAM) and Udyam Registration (UR) Portals till 15.03.2022 is at Annexure-I.

(b) & (c): The Government has taken a number of measures for promotion, development, financial incentivisation and for enhancing the competitiveness of MSME sector. These inter alia include (i) Rs. 20,000 crore Subordinate Debt for MSMEs; (ii) Rs.3 lakh crores Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme (ECLGS) for Businesses, including MSMEs (subsequently been increased to Rs. 5 lakh crore, as announced in Budget 2022-23); (iii) Rs. 50,000 crore equity infusion through Self Reliant India Fund; (iv) New Revised classification of MSMEs based on composite criteria of investment in Plant & Machinery or equipment and Turnover; (v) No Global tenders for Government procurements upto Rs. 200 crore, etc.

(d): The State/UT-wise number of MSMEs currently functioning and the number of those shut down is at Annexure -II.

(e): The economic package announced under Aatma Nirbhar Bharat Abhiyan was aimed at providing relief to MSMEs to overcome the adverse effect of COVID-19. In addition, the Government had announced following initiatives for MSMEs in the Budget 2022-23:-

- (i) Udyam, e-Shram, NCS and ASEEM portals will be interlinked for credit facilitation, skilling and recruitment.
- (ii) Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme (ECLGS) to be extended up to March 2023 and its guarantee cover to be expanded by Rs. 50,000 crore, with the additional amount being earmarked exclusively for the hospitality and related enterprises.
- (iii) Credit Guarantee Trust for Micro and Small Enterprises (CGTMSE) scheme to be revamped with required infusion of funds to facilitate additional credit of Rs. 2 lakh crore for MSEs and expand employment opportunities.
- (iv) Roll out of Raising and Accelerating MSME Performance (RAMP) programme with an outlay of Rs. 6,000 crore over 5 years.
