TRAINING IN SKILL DEVELOPMENT

1722. Shri K.J. Alphons:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) how many persons have been trained in skill development during the last three years, category-wise;
- (b) how many of these have found a job, category-wise; and
- (c) whether Government take the initiative to find a placement for all those who are being trained by them?

(a) Under Skill India Mission, the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship is delivering skills through a comprehensive network of skill development centres under various schemes viz. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS), Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) and Jan Sikhshan Sansthan (JSS) to youth across the country. The number of persons trained under PMKVY, NAPS, ITIs and JSS during last three years category-wise are attached at Annexure-I, Annexure-II, Annexure-III and Annexure-IV respectively.

(b) The number of persons placed under PMKVY is at Annexure-I.

ITIs- The establishment and day-to-day administration of ITIs comes under the jurisdiction of State Government, while Central Government has the responsibilities for setting up the criteria for affiliation, examination, certification and designing curriculum. As per report of the Tracer Study of ITI Graduates 2018 conducted by the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship through Mott MacDonald, an Independent Agency, 63.5 % of ITI Graduates are employed of which 6.7 % are self-employed.

JSS: The objective of training imparted under JSS is to encourage the individuals for gainful livelihood and supplement their family income through self-employment and wage employment. The providing of employment/placement to the beneficiaries is not the mandate of the JSS Scheme. As far as the employment of the JSS scheme beneficiaries is concerned, third party evaluation report of the scheme has mentioned, "It is finally observed that as an impact of the training programme conducted at JSSs, the self and wage employment and

private job have become evident". The usefulness of the scheme would be further self-evident from the fact that same report has mentioned that 77.05% of the beneficiary trainees have under gone occupational shifts.

NAPS: Since NAPS is an apprenticeship based scheme placements are not tracked.

(c) Yes, Sir. Under PMKVY scheme, various initiatives are taken to ensure better placement outcomes for the trained/ certified candidates. *Rojgar Melas* are conducted for placement of youth by industry. MSDE has launched Aatmanirbhar Skilled Employees Employer Mapping (ASEEM) portal, which acts as a directory of skilled workforce. The objective is to provide a platform that matches supply of skilled workforce with the market demand, thereby facilitating better livelihood opportunities for youth and availability of ready skilled manpower to employers. PMKVY3.0 envisages working more closely with the State and District machineries through State Skill Development Mission (SSDMs) and District Skill Committees (DSCs).

The policies for placement assistance or support for self-employment are part of administration in ITIs.
