ENTREPRENEURS SUPPORTED UNDER PM FME IN MAHARASHTRA

1214. SHRI SANJAY RAUT:

Will the MINISTER OF ***FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES*** be pleased to state:

- (a) how many entrepreneurs have been supported under Pradhan Mantri Formalisation of Micro food processing Enterprises (PM FME) scheme in Maharashtra since its inception;
- (b) how much fund has been allocated so far by the Central Government under this scheme;
- (c) the number of proposals currently pending with Government and by when they will be sanctioned; and
- (d) whether any target has been fixed by the Ministry under PM FME scheme for the State of Maharashtra for the next two years, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

- (a): 68 entrepreneurs have been supported for setting up of micro food processing units under Pradhan Mantri Formalisation of Micro food processing Enterprises (PM FME) scheme in Maharashtra since its inception.
- (b): Rs.50.31 crores have been released so far by the Ministry of Food Processing Industries (MoFPI) to the state of Maharashtra for implementation of PMFME scheme.
- (c): Currently, no proposals are pending with the MoFPI from Maharashtra under the PMFME scheme.
- (d): Target of 22,234 individual units in respect of Maharashtra has been fixed for 5 years, from 2020-21 to 2024-25.
