2264. Dr. L. Hanumanthaiah:

Will the Minister of **Education** be pleased to state:

- (a) the list of all Central Universities in the country and the number of departments in each university;
- (b) the number of departments in the Central University of Karnataka (CUK), Kalaburagi, the details thereof;
- (c) how many departments are already operational in CUK, Kalaburagi and how many more are being planned to be opened there;
- (d) whether the number of departments in CUK, Kalaburagi is lesser than the average number of departments in other Central Universities;
- (e) if so, the reason therefor; and
- (f) by when the new departments will be opened and made functional?

(a): Presently, there are 46 Central Universities under Ministry of Education. The details of the number of Departments in each University are available at https://www.education.gov.in/en/parl_ques.

(b) & (c): There are 27 Departments of Studies in Central University of Karnataka, Kalaburagi at present and all these Departments are functional. The details are available at https://www.education.gov.in/en/parl_ques.

(d) to (f): Central Universities are statutory autonomous bodies established and incorporated under Acts of Parliament. They are governed by provisions of the Act, Statutes and Ordinances made thereunder. Under the provisions of Central Universities Act, 2009, Executive Council of the University has the power to establish Centres of Studies/Departments on the recommendations of the Academic Council.
