Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the reasons for the delay in conducting the decadal census in 2021;
- (b) the proposed timeline for conducting the 2021 census and release of the results; and
- (c) whether any changes have been proposed to the contents of the questionnaire, if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI NITYANAND RAI)

- (a) & (b): The intent of the Government for conducting Census 2021 was notified in Gazette of India on 28th March, 2019. However, due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic, the conduct of Census 2021 and the related field activities have been postponed until further orders.
- (c): The Questionnaire for the first phase of Census i.e. Houselisting and Housing Census was notified in the Gazette of India on 9th January, 2020.
