SLOWDOWN OF DEMAND FOR TEXTILE EXPORTS

794. SHRI SANJAY RAUT:

Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Indian textile producers/exporters are witnessing slowdown in demand for their textile products;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and Government's observations thereon;
- (c) whether it is also a fact that Indian ready-made garments export has dropped drastically since last five years;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and Government's response thereto; and
- (e) whether Government is considering to launch the second round of Production-Linked Incentives (PLI) in textiles to boost production of apparel and garments for exports, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): The details of Indian textiles & Ready Made Garments (RMG) export during the last five years including the current year are as follows:

India's textile industry has recovered and has posted record performance during 2021-22. The export of RMG has witnessed an increase of 31% in 2021-22 as compared to 2020-21. The growth in RMG is continuing during April- May 2022 when compared to last year for the same period.
