**Recruitment to clerical posts in PSBs in Kerala**

1013. SHRI A. A. RAHIM:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the data on the number of vacancies in clerical posts in each of the Public Sector Banks (PSBs) in Kerala;
- (b) the number of clerical vacancies in Kerala for which the Institute of Banking Personnel Selection (IBPS) has released advertisement;
- (c) the reasons for the appointment process being restricted to few vacant posts;
- (d) the reasons for so many banks having zero recruitment in spite of many vacancies; and
- (e) whether the Ministry is planning to take any action on the matter, if so the details thereof?

(a) to (e): As per the inputs provided by Public Sector Banks (PSBs), the details of the banks having the vacancies, along with the position of vacancies in clerical posts is as under:-

Indian Overseas Bank	47
State Bank of India	273

Institute of Banking Personnel Selection (IBPS) has released advertisement for 70 vacant posts of clerks in PSBs (other than State Bank of India) for the state of Kerala.

Further, banks undertake staff recruitment to fill vacancies on ongoing basis as per their business requirement.
