- (a) the locations in Bihar where super speciality hospitals were proposed to be set up under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthaya Suraksha Yojana phase-3;
- (b) the details of initially projected cost of each of these hospitals and the revised cost due to the delayed process;
- (c) the details of the physical and financial progress of each of the hospitals; and
- (d) the details of funds provided by the Central and the State Government respectively, so far?

(a) to (d): In Bihar, Government Medical College, Darbhanga and Sri Krishna Medical College, Muzaffarpur have been taken up for upgradation under Phase-III of Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY). This upgradation involves construction / setting up of Super Speciality Block (SSB) at both the Government Medical Colleges (GMCs). The details are as under:
