OBJECTIONS OF RAMP

900. SHRI PRABHAKAR REDDY VEMIREDDY:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of aims and objectives of Raising and Accelerating Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) Performance (RAMP);
- (b) whether an outlay of ₹6000 crores was allocated in the Budget for 2022-23;
- (c) if so, the manner in which this budgetary allocation is proposed to be utilized; and
- (d) whether the said amount is proposed to be spent State-wise or Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises-wise?

ANSWER

(a): The World Bank supported Central Sector Scheme “Raising and Accelerating MSME Performance” aims at strengthening Institutions and governance of MSME programme at the Centre and States, and increasing MSME sector’s access to credit and market, and increasing firm capabilities through technology upgradation, greening initiatives, reducing incidence of delayed payments, etc.

(b) & (c): The total outlay for the scheme over the programme implementation period of 5 years is ₹6062.45 crores. This budget will be utilised for supporting Institutional and policy reforms, research studies, integration of portals within the Ministries/ Departments, increasing firm level capabilities through technology upgradation, reducing incidence of delayed payments, etc.

(d): Under the RAMP programme, all States/UTs will be invited to prepare Strategic Investment Plans (SIPs), and the projects proposed in the SIPs will be funded based on their appraisals by the Ministry of MSME.
