Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the State-wise number of villages adopted under the Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana (SAGY);
- (b) the number of villages where this scheme has been completed during the last three years; and
- (c) the reasons due to which this scheme is incomplete in other villages?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

- (a) The Hon'ble Members of Parliament have identified 2916 Gram Panchayats across the country under Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana (SAGY) since its inception. The State/UT wise number of GPs identified under SAGY is given in Annexure-I.
- (b) & (c) The Gram Panchayats prepare a Village Development Plan (VDP) in which the proposed activities are implemented through convergence of various schemes of the Government of India and State schemes. It aims to trigger processes that lead to the holistic development of the identified Gram Panchayats. As per the data available on the scheme portal, 164 Gram Panchayats have completed all the proposed activities under VDP during the last three years. There is continuous and progressive development of the other Gram Panchayats (GPs) also under SAGY. As per the latest data on scheme portal (https://saanjhi.gov.in), Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana (SAGY) Gram Panchayats have been successful in completing the implementation of 91,383 projects (60%), out of the 1,50,222 projects planned under Village Development Plan (VDP).
