(d) the number of youths trained under the said skill development projects, and the details of the companies where employment has been provided to them?

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI RAJEEV CHANDRASEKHAR)

(a) The Government is implementing various Skill Development Schemes/Programmes across Central Ministries/Departments, for providing a range of Skill Development training programmes on pan India basis. Under Skill India Mission, the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship is delivering skills through following skill development schemes across the country including Rajasthan:

1	Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY)	With an aim to empower country's youth and continue the journey of Skill India Mission in building India as the skill capital of the world, the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) launched the third phase of its flagship scheme— Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY 3.0) in January 2021.	
2	Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS) Scheme	Scheme of Jan Shikshan Sansthan (NGOs) for Skill Development to impart vocational skills in non-formal mode to non-literate, neo-literates, persons with rudimentary level of education upto 8 th and school drop- outs upto 12 th standard in the age group of 15-45 years. The priority groups are women, SC, ST, minorities and	

		other backward sections of the society.
3	National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS)	This Scheme is for promoting apprenticeship training and increasing the engagement of apprentices by providing financial support to industrial establishments undertaking apprenticeship program under The Apprentices Act, 1961.
4	Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs)/ Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS)	This scheme is for providing long-term training through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) operational across the country.The it is offer a range of vocational/skill training courses covering a large number of economic sectors with an objective of providing skilled workforce to the industry as well as self-employment of youth.

(b) The project-wise and year-wise details of funds spent on these projects during last three years are attached at **Annexure-I**.

(c) In the State of Rajasthan, 1590 training centres (including PMKKs) are currently operational under PMVKY (PMKVY 2.0 & PMKVY 3.0). Under Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS), 1489 Private Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) and 160 GovernmentITIsare running in Rajasthan. The JSS Scheme is implemented through NGOs. In Rajasthan, there are total 8 JSSs in which 6 are existing and 2 are newly sanctioned during FY-2021-22. As far as NAPS is concerned, apprentices are getting trained in 1975 establishments. These establishments are industrial and accept apprentices on government funding.
