EDUCATION OF CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES

1254. SHRI NEERAJ DANGI:

Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has conducted any assessment regarding the education of children with disabilities, if so, the State-wise/UT-wise details of such children who are currently studying;
- (b) whether Government has adequate number of trained teachers to provide education to children with disabilities or children with special needs; and
- (c) whether Government is providing any satellite based education for these children, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT (SUSHRI PRATIMA BHOUMIK)

- (a) The Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education conducted the National Achievement Survey (NAS) of Classes III, V & VIII in 2017, Class X in 2018 and Class III, V, VIII and X in 2021. Through the survey in 2021, students in Government, Government-aided and Private unaided schools across 720 districts in all 36 States & UTs were assessed, based on the Learning Outcomes developed by NCERT. Over 34 lakh students including children with disability participated in the survey. The survey process incorporated provisions such as additional time, scribes and suitable adaptations as per the needs of children with disability in order to facilitate an equitable assessment of all children.
- (b) As per Unified District Information System for Education (UDISE+) 2019-20, the State/UT-wise detail of teachers who have been imparted training on Inclusive Education module in the year 2019-20 is at Annexure-I.In addition, there are 1,42,357 special educators registered as on date as per Central Rehabilitation Register of Rehabilitation Council of India. State/UT-wise number of such registered special educators is at Annexure-II.

- (c) Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education has informed that the Video Contents on SWAYAMPRABHA TV channels, now named as PM eVidya DTH TV Channels (12 DTH TV Channels for school education under "one class, one channel" initiative) are generally available in Hindi and English languages except for the language /literature specific contents where respective Assamese as shared by State Council of Educational Research and Training (SCERT) Assam are also being shown on PM eVidya DTH TV channels, viz., classes 6,7,8,9 & 11.
- 3,464 audiobook chapters have been developed and uploaded on DIKSHA and also scheduled for telecast on PM eVIDYA DTH TV channels. In addition, Teaching Learning Interventions for Inclusive Classrooms Ask the Expert: 335 live sessions covering about 167.5 hours have also been delivered as part of the Government's endeavour for inclusive education.
