**MOBILE AND INTERNET CONNECTIVITY IN POST OFFICES**

**1493 SHRI SUJEET KUMAR:**

Will the Minister of Communications be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is aware of the fact that there are Post Offices, especially in areas with difficult terrains, without a mobile network or internet connectivity;
- (b) the State-wise details of such Post Offices in the country, including Odisha;
- (c) the steps that Government has taken to ensure that network connectivity reaches such Post Offices; and
- (d) whether Government has set any deadline for ensuring network connectivity in such areas?

(a) & (b) Connectivity in Post offices in rural areas with difficult terrain is dependent on network availability in those areas. State / Union Territory-wise list of post offices without mobile network or internet connectivity including Odisha is enclosed as **Annexure**.

(c) & (d) Department of Posts has brought in network connectivity in difficult areas by exploring connectivity options through Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL), other private service providers and alternate technologies such as V-SAT (Very-Small Aperture Terminal) and IDR (Inter-Domain Routing). Department is working proactively with service providers to ensure connectivity in all post offices.
