- (c) whether Government intends to act on the recommendations of the Institute of Economic Growth (IEG) to scrap the scheme;
- (d) whether Government intends to reform the scheme in line with concerns on its implementation and scholarship amount;
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (f) the reasons why the IEG report and methodology are not publicly available?
