(a) & (b): In the State of Bihar, 59 Railway stations have been identified from time to time for development under the Adarsh Station Scheme. The details are as under:

(c): The expenditure on development of stations under Adarsh Station Scheme is generally funded under Plan Head –53 'Customer Amenities'. The details of allocation of funds and expenditure incurred for development and maintenance of stations including for Adarsh Station Scheme are maintained zonal Railway-wise and not station-wise or state-wise. There are 04 zones, namely, Eastern Railway, Northeast Frontier Railway, North Eastern Railway and East Central Railway, which cater to the State of Bihar. The details of funds allocated and expenditure incurred by the 04 Railways under Plan Head-53 'Customer Amenities', during last three years and current year i.e. 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23 (till June, 2022) is as under:-
