**COMPLETION OF WORK UNDER JJM**

1701# SHRI NARHARI AMIN:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:-

- (a) the target date set for completion of Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM);
- (b) the number of States in the country where the work has started under this Mission;
- (c) the number of districts along with the number of villages under these districts where the work has been completed so far under this Mission in Gujarat; and
- (d) by when the work is likely to be completed in the villages where the work is not complete, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

(a) & (b) Since August, 2019, to make provision of potable tap water supply to every rural household of the country by 2024, Government of India, in partnership with States is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) – Har Ghar Jal. Under JJM, work has started in all 28 States of the country.

(c) & (d) As reported by State Government, out of total 18,191 villages in 33 districts of the State, work has been completed in 17 districts having 7,743 villages. Besides, in remaining 16 districts, work has also been completed in 8,364 villages. Thus, out of 18,191 villages the work has been completed in 16,107 villages and in the remaining 2,084 villages, the State Government has planned to complete the work by September, 2022.
