'EASE OF DOING BUSINESS' FOR THE FISHERY SECTOR

1712. DR. K. LAXMAN:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the steps taken/being taken by Government for making a favourable environment to boost Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) sector under 'Ease of Doing Business' for the entrepreneurs specially in the fisheries business in Telangana;
- (b) the number of registration done through Udyam Registration (UR) Portal from the State of Telangana, district-wise;
- (c) the details of promotional activities in the State to encourage the entrepreneurs for leveraging the schemes sponsored by Government;
- (d) any roadblocks/constraints in implementing Government schemes in the State; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and steps taken/being taken by the State Government in this regard?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI BHANU PRATAP SINGH VERMA)

- (a): The Government has taken several steps for making favourable environment to boost the micro, small and medium enterprise (MSME) sector in the country under Ease of Doing Business, including in the state of Telangana. Some of these are given below:
 - (i) Udyam Registration (UR) Portal provides fully online, paperless and transparent MSME registration process. No documents or proof are required to be uploaded for registering an MSME. Only Aadhaar Number and PAN is enough for registration. PAN and GST linked details on investment and turnover of enterprises are taken automatically from Government databases.
 - (ii) Digital Payments to pass on the benefits of the schemes of Ministry of MSME through digital payment gateway.
 - (iii) MSME SAMBANDH Portal- helps in monitoring the implementation of Public Procurement Policy for micro and small enterprises.
 - (iv) MSME SAMADHAAN Portal- helps in empowering micro and small entrepreneurs across the country to register their cases relating to delayed payments.
 - (v) Champions Portal for speedy redressal of grievances.
 - (vi) Under Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012, the number of regulatory compliances in regard to Government to Business and Government to Citizen, has been reduced from 7 to 4.
 - (vii) Government e-Marketplace (GeM)- facilitates online procurement of common use Goods & Services required by various Government Departments/ Organizations/ CPSEs.

'Fishing and aquaculture' activity is not included in the manufacture or production of goods or providing or rendering of services in accordance with Section 7 of MSMED Act, 2006.

- (b): The district-wise details of registrations done through the Udyam Registrastion Portal from the State of Telangana are at Annexure.
- (c): As informed by Government of Telangana, they regularly follow-up with Agencies and Bankers in all meetings including State Level Bankers Committee (SLBC)/ District Consultative Committee (DCC)/ Federation of Telangana Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FTCCI), etc.
- (d): The Government of Telangana has informed that they facilitate all the schemes at State and District level. As such there have been no road blocks in implementation.
- (e): Does not arise in view of (d) above.
