CONSTRUCTION OF FOUR LANE RANCHI-VARANASI NH

2009. SHRI SAMIR ORAON:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of phases under which NH 75 Ranchi-Varanasi four lane would be constructed;
- (b) by when NH 75 Ranchi-Varanasi four lane road being constructed under Bharatmala Project likely to be completed;
- (c) the projected cost of the said project;
- (d) whether any complaint has been received against the company constructing this four lane for not maintaining the quality standards; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) National Highway 75 (New NH-39) originates at Ranchi and traverses through Chandwa, Gharwa, Wyandhamganj (UP/JH Border) in the State of Jharkhand; Renukoot, Shakti Nagar (UP/MP border) in the State of Uttar Pradesh; Singrauli, Sidhi, Deori Ghat (UP/MP border) in the State of Madhya Pradesh and terminates at Jhansi in the Uttar Pradesh. The development of NH-75 (New NH-39) in the State of Jharkhand to 4 lane configuration with estimated cost of Rs. 7000 crore has been taken up in 7 construction packages with completion planned by the year 2024-25 as detailed below:
