**RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS IN PUNJAB**

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the proposals received from Government of Punjab for development in rural areas in the State during the last three years and the current year;
- (b) the proposals received which are pending during the said period;
- (c) whether Government proposes to formulate any special scheme regarding development of rural areas of Punjab; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

(a) & (b): The Department of Rural Development (DoRD) is implementing a number of developmental schemes, namely, Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (Mahatma Gandhi NREGS), Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana – Gramin (PMAY-G), Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY), Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana – National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM), Deen Dayal Upadhyay – Gramin Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY), Rural Self Employment Training Institutes (RSETIs), National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP) and Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission (SPMRM). Apart from proposals relating to fund releases under these schemes, which is a continuous process, there are no other proposals pending from the State of Punjab.

(c) & (d): At present, there is no proposal to formulate specific scheme regarding development of rural areas of Punjab.
