THE MINISTER OF CULTURE (SHRIMATI AMBIKA SONI): (a) to (c) A Memorandum of Understanding on cooperation for conservation of the paintings of the Ajanta and Ellora Caves was entered into on February 15, 2005, under the aegis of the Indo-Italian Cultural Exchange Programme (2003-05).

The work on the project commenced in Oct. 2005. The project is expected to help to exchange experiences in the field between the Indian and Italian experts towards better conservation of mural paints of Ajanta and Ellora.

A seminar on 'The Archaeological Site of Ajanta: Reflections, on the Indo-Italian Conservation Project' and a training course on conservation and restoration of archaeological and historical ceramic and glass objects was conducted at National Museum, Delhi on February, 14, 2007 and February 12-28, 2007 respectively.
