DETAILS OF SCHEMES FOR DISABLED

2056: SHRI IRANNA KADADI:

Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of National Institutes (NIs), Composite Regional Centres (CRCs) and District Disability Rehabilitation Centres (DDRCs) functioning in the country at present, State-wise particularly in Karnataka;
- (b) the services rendered by the said institutes/centres for the differently abled;
- (c) whether Government has provided grants-in-aid to such centres during each of the last two years and the current year and if so, the details thereof alongwith the number of beneficiaries, State-wise; and
- (d) whether Government has reviewed the working of such centres during the said period and if so, the outcome thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT
(SUSHRI PRATIMA BHOUMIK)

(a) There are nine National Institutes (NIs) and twenty one Composite Regional Centres (CRCs) functioning in the country. 63 DDRCs are currently functioning in the country with the assistance of the Central Government. The State-wise details of NIs, CRCs and (DDRCs) are at **Annexure-I**.

(b) The services rendered by the said Institutes/Centres for differently abled are as follows:-

- i. Rehabilitation services;
- ii. Provision of aids and assistive devices;
- iii. Skill Development;
- iv. Capacity development in the field of rehabilitation of persons with disabilities; and

- v. Research on disability related matters.
- vi. Survey & identification of persons with disabilities through camp approach; facilitation of disability certificate, bus passes and other concession/facilities for persons with disabilities; assisting in the issue of Unique Disability Identity Card (UDID) to divyangjan in the District;
- vii. Awareness Generation for encouraging and enhancing prevention of disabilities, early detection and intervention as well as maintaining data of organizations working for the empowerment of persons with disabilities in the district etc..
- viii. Early Intervention and facilitating Insurance Schemes launched by the National Trust/Department for Divyangjan;
- ix. Assessment of need of assistive devices, provision/fitment of assistive devices, follow up/repair of assistive devices, assisting the ADIP/ALMICO camps for distribution of aids and assistive devices in the district;
- x. Therapeutic Services e.g. Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy etc.;
- xi. Referral and arrangement of surgical correction through Government & Charitable institutes;
- xii. Arrangement of loans for self employment, through banks & other financial institutions;
- xiii. Counseling of persons with disabilities, their parents & family members;
- xiv. Promotion of barrier free environment and to play an active role in the Accessible India campaign of the department;
- xv. To provide supportive and complimentary services to promote education, assisting students with disabilities for availing Scholarship Schemes of the Department, vocational training/ Skill Training of eligible Divangjan and employment for persons with disabilities;
- xvi. Provide referral services for existing educational training, vocational institutions and to act as Outreach centre for the services provided by the National Institutes and Composite Regional Centres.

(c) The details of funds released to NIs and CRCs during last two years and current year and details of beneficiaries are given at **Annexure-II**. State wise and year wise funds released to DDRCs for the last two years & current year are given at **Annexure III**. Services available in each DDRC are provided to all Persons with Disabilities (PwDs) and records of beneficiaries of DDRC scheme is not maintained centrally.

(d) DDRC is run under the supervision of a District management Team headed by the District collector. DMT includes district officials from Social Welfare, Health, Panchayati Raj, Women & Child Welfare Departments, nodal officer from implementing agency and representative from reputed NGOs. The working of DDRCs are reviewed by the DMT from time to time and grants are released only on the recommendation of the DM and the State Governments. Further, the working of DDRCs is also evaluated by independent agency. The last Third-Party Evaluation was conducted by National Institute of Labour Economics

Research and Development (NILRED) in the year 2020-21 has found the working of DDRCs as satisfactory.

Government reviews the functioning of the NIs and CRCs regularly by taking Review Meetings. Other than that, performances of the NIs/CRCs are also monitored by the Executive Council and General Council of the respective National Institute. As a result, services and infrastructure of NIs/CRCs/DDRCs have increased significantly.
