2270. SHRI IRANNA KADADI:

Will the Minister of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has launched any scheme to provide seeds at lower prices to the farmers living below the poverty line, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the number of farmers benefited under such scheme during the last three years and the current year;
- (c) whether the Government has utilized the services of Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs) to provide seeds to the farmers; and
- (d) If so, the details thereof and the other steps taken by the Government to provide high yielding seeds, fertilizers and irrigation facilities to farmers at lower prices to make agriculture a profitable profession?

ANSWER

- (a): Government of India provides financial assistance to different States and Government Seed Producing Agencies for production and distribution of seeds and for other interventions related to seed sector *viz*. Sub-Mission on Seeds and Planting Materials (SMSP), National Food Security Mission (NFSM), Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) etc. The pattern of assistance for seed production, distribution and other seed related activities under the schemes of DA&FW is at **Annexure-I**.
- (b): The details of farmers benefitted under Seed Village Programme of Sub-Mission on Seeds and Planting Materials (SMSP) scheme (as provided by the States) during the last three years and the current year is as under:

For the current year, physical progress will be available only after completion of current season i.e. Kharif-2022 as and when provided by the States.

- (c): Government of India provides assistance to different State Governments/UTs and Implementing Agencies under various schemes, which further distribute it to small and marginal farmers.
- (d): Seed distributed under the above mentioned schemes of DA&FW includes high yielding certified/quality seeds. In case of irrigation facilities, financial assistance to farmers is available under different components of various schemes viz. Sub-Mission on Agriculture Mechanization (SMAM), Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH) etc. Department is also implementing Per Drop More Crop Scheme since 2015-16 which mainly focuses on water use efficiency at farm level through Micro Irrigation (Drip and Sprinkler Irrigation System). For Fertilizers, in order to ensure the easy availability of major fertilizers of good quality at affordable prices, the GoI has fixed a statutory price of urea at Rs. 242/45kg bags. The difference between the delivered cost of urea at farm gate and net market realization by the urea units is given as subsidy to the urea manufacturer/importer by the GoI. Similarly in case of P&K fertilizers, the GoI provide subsidy under the Nutrient based Subsidy Scheme (NBS), so that these fertilizers shall make available to the farmers at affordable price.
