DRINKING WATER UNDER NAL SE JAL SCHEME

104#: MS. SAROJ PANDEY:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of rural households targeted to provide drinking water under 'Nal Se Jal' scheme in Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand and Odisha;
- (b) the number of households which have been provided this facility with respect to this target so far; and
- (c) by when remaining households are likely to be provided such facility along with the expenditure proposed to be made by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) Government of India, in partnership with State Governments including Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, and Odisha, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM)-'Har Ghar Jal' to make provision for potable tap water supply to each rural household through Functional Household Tap Connection (FHTC) by 2024.

As reported by Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand and Odisha, the physical progress in terms of tap water supply to rural households during JJM implementation period, is as under:

Chhattisgarh	50.06	3.19	12.27	9.08

Odisha	88.57	3.11	43.63	40.52

The allocation of funds under JJM to States/ UTs is on an annual basis. During 2022-23, the allocation of JJM funds to these States is as under:

As reported by the States of Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand and Odisha, remaining households are likely to be provided such facility within the Mission time line of 2024.
