Will the **MINISTER OF CULTURE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has any mechanism to establish special cultural fund for organising cultural events at the district level to promote the incredible culture of the country, specially in the State of Punjab;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the details of the concerned officials and nodal agencies regarding the aforementioned purpose?

ANSWER

- (a)&(b) The Ministry of Culture administers various schemes such as Repertory Grant, Cultural Function Production Grant and Financial Assistance to Cultural Organisation with National Presence under which grants are being given as financial assistance to the organisations to organise cultural events throughout the country including the State of Punjab. Besides, Seven Zonal Cultural Centres across the country play a key role in promotion of culture through the programmes decided in consultation with their member States. Punjab is a member State of North Zone Cultural Centre (NZCC) and a part of the grant provided to NZCC is being utilized to organise cultural programmes in Punjab. However, the execution process is not administered at district level.
- (c) Details of the concerned officials and nodal agencies that are administering various Scheme of the Ministry are given as under:-
