**IMPLEMENTATION OF 'HAR GHAR NAL SE JAL' SCHEME IN GUJARAT**

106#. SHRI NARHARI AMIN:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state :-

- (a) the status of implementation of 'Har GharNal se Jal' scheme in the State of Gujarat;
- (b) the district-wise number of households getting the benefits of this scheme so far; and
- (c) the details of funds allocated for the said scheme so far?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (c) Since August 2019, the Government of India in partnership with States, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) – Har Ghar Jal, to make provision of potable tap water supply to every rural household in the country by 2024.

At the time of the announcement of the mission in August 2019, only 65.16 Lakhs (71%) of rural households in the State were reported to have the provision of tap water supply. Since then, provision of the tap water supply has been made in 23.41 Lakhs rural households in the State. As on 12<sup>th</sup> July 2022, out of 91.77 Lakh rural households in Gujarat, 88.57Lakh (96.51%) rural households are having provision of tap water supply. The district-wise details of total rural households having provision of tap water supply, as on 12<sup>th</sup> July 2022 is at **Annex**.

Under JJM, the details of funds allocated as on 12<sup>th</sup> July 2022 is as under:
