## PROPOSALS FOR URBAN DEVELOPMENT IN AMRAVATI, MAHARASHTRA

### NO. 236. DR. ANIL SUKHDEORAO BONDE:

#### Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has formulated any plan for urban development;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the number of proposals received from the Government of Madhya Pradesh for urban development along with the details thereof, district-wise;
- (d) whether municipal bodies of Amravati district falling within Amravati have been included in this scheme;
- (e) if so, the proposals of municipal bodies of Amravati district in Maharashtra State included therein; and
- (f) the details of work proposed to be undertaken therein?

## ANSWER THE MINISTER OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI HARDEEP SINGH PURI)

(a) to (f): A Statement is laid on the Table of the House.

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Statement as referred to in part (a) to (f) in reply to Rajya Sabha Starred Question No 236 due for answer on 08 August, 2022 regarding 'Proposals for Urban Development in Amravati, Maharashtra'.

- (a)&(b) Urban Development is a State subject. Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) facilitates and assists States / Union Territories (UTs) in urban development through its flagship Missions / Schemes-Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) 2.0, Smart Cities Mission (SCM), Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban (PMAY-U) and Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban (SBM-U) 2.0, and Urban Transport projects. The Schemes are implemented by the States / UTs in accordance with the Mission / Scheme guidelines. AMRUT 2.0 focuses on universal coverage of water supply in all in statutory towns and universal coverage of sewerage and septic management in 500 AMRUT cities of phase-I; SCM on sustainable and inclusive development in selected 100 cities to improve the quality of life of all; SBM 2.0 envisions 'Garbage Free Cities' and its objectives include sustainable solid waste management, sustainable sanitation and liquid waste management including use of treated used water.; PMAY-U supports provision of houses to eligible urban households including slum dwellers and Urban Transport initiatives cover Metro and transport related projects.
  - (c) Details of projects taken up or proposals received from the Government of Madhya Pradesh under the Missions/ Schemes of MoHUA are given in Annexure I.
- (d) to (f) The Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) of Amravati district are covered under the Missions/Schemes except the Smart Cities Mission. The proposals of the municipalities and works taken up or proposed to be undertaken are in Annexure II.
