(a) and (b): Chhattisgarh and Odisha are Decentralized Procurement (DCP) states wherein procurement of paddy is undertaken by State Govt. through its agencies and only the surplus rice after meeting State's requirement, is delivered to Food Corporation of India (FCI) in central pool.
