AMRUT IN RAJASTHAN

NO. 2457. SHRI RAJENDRA GEHLOT:

Will the Minister of Housing and Urban Affairs be pleased to state:

- (a) the current status of ongoing projects under the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) in the State of Rajasthan;
- (b) the details of the funds allocated and utilized under the said mission in Rajasthan during last three years, district-wise; and
- (c) whether there has been any delay in this project, if so, the details of complaints received in this regard?

ANSWER

(a): Under Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT), the State of Rajasthan has grounded 31 water supply projects worth ₹1,038 crore, of which 11 projects worth ₹307 crore have been completed. 6.87 lakh household water tap connections have been provided through AMRUT and in convergence with other schemes against the target of 6.67 lakh water tap connections. Water Treatment Plant (WTP) of capacity 18 Million Litres Per Day (MLD) is in progress. Under Sewerage sector, of the 33 grounded projects worth ₹2,302 crore, 12 projects worth ₹597 crore have been completed. So far, 4.57 lakh sewer connections/septage coverage have been provided through AMRUT and in convergence with other schemes against the target of 11.29 lakh sewer connections. 88 MLD of sewage treatment capacity has already been developed and another 37 MLD is in progress. Around 10.79 km of drainage network has also been developed, and 13 water logging points have been eliminated through storm water drainage projects. Also 301 acres of green space has been developed.

(b): Under AMRUT, funds have been allocated for entire mission period, not year-wise/ district-wise. As regards the State of Rajasthan, the total approved State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) is ₹3,224 crore for projects against which total committed Central Assistance (CA) is ₹1,542 crore for entire mission period. Further, details of Central funds released to the State of Rajasthan during the last three years is as under:
