**PLANS FOR DEVELOPMENT OF NEW TOURISM CIRCUITS IN  
UTTARAKHAND**

Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has formulated any plans for integrated development of new tourism circuits dedicated to themes under Central Sector Scheme like Swadesh Darshan Scheme for the State of Uttarakhand;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the amount of funds released for developing tourism infrastructure in the current financial year?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (c): The Ministry of Tourism had launched the Swadesh Darshan Scheme (SDS) in the year 2014-15 with a vision to develop theme based tourist circuits in the country and has sanctioned 76 projects throughout the country including in the State of Uttarakhand.

Details of the projects sanctioned in the State of Uttarakhand under SDS is given below:
