2036 SHRI R. GIRIRAJAN:

Will the Minister of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship be pleased to state:

- (a) the status of Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY);
- (b) the list of centres set up in the State of Tamil Nadu, district-wise; and
- (c) the amount of funds allocated, disbursed and utilised, State-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI RAJEEV CHANDRASEKHAR)

- (a) Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) was launched in 2015. PMKVY has been now launched in three phases PMKVY 1.0 (2015-16), PMKVY 2.0 (2016-20) and PMKVY 3.0 (2020-22). Since inception, till 30.06.2022, 1.36 crore candidates have been benefited from the PMKVY across the country. An amount of Rs. 8590.29 Crore has been disbursed to implementing agency i.e. National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) and Rs. 1244.20 Crore to States/UTs under PMKVY. Out of this, NSDC has utilized Rs. 7877.15 Crore and States/UTs has utilized Rs. 877.48 Crore.
- (b) PMKVY is being implemented through empanelled Training Centres (TCs), including established model training centres known as Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra (PMKK) across the country including the State of Tamil Nadu. The district-wise number of empanelled TCs including PMKK in the State of Tamil Nadu, as on 30.06.2022 is given at Annexure-I.
- (c) The PMKVY (except PMKVY 1.0) has two components, namely Centrally Sponsored Centrally Managed (CSCM) component being implemented through National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) and Centrally Sponsored State Managed (CSSM) component being implemented through State Skill Development Mission of the State/UT. Under CSCM component of PMKVY, there is no provision of State-wise funds allocation.

Under CSSM component of PMKVY, funds and corresponding physical targets have been allocated to the States for the implementation of scheme through State Skill Development Missions (SSDMs). The State-wise fund allocated, disbursed and utilized by the State under PMKVY 2.0 and PMKVY 3.0, as on 30.06.2022, is given at Annexure-II.
