Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of businesses that benefitted from the Scheme of Fund for Regeneration of Traditional Industries (SFURTI) and Credit Guarantee Scheme (CGTMSE) during the last three years;
- (b) the list of beneficiaries from National Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Hub (NSSH), State/UT-wise;
- (c) the details of the budget spent for awareness of the campaigns run by Government; and
- (d) the details of the districts receiving integrated services provided by the NSIC, State/UT-wise?

(a): The Scheme of Fund for Regeneration of Traditional Industries (SFURTI) is a scheme to organize traditional industries and artisans into clusters and provide them with sustainable income generation. The traditional industries covered under the scheme are from textiles, handicraft, agro processing, bamboo, honey, khadi and coir sector etc. 365 Clusters have been approved during the last three years and around Rs. 1025 crore released benefitting 209741 artisans/beneficiaries.

The Credit Guarantee Scheme (CGTMSE) aims to strengthen credit delivery system and to facilitate flow of credit to the MSE sector, create access to finance for unserved, under served and underprivileged. The details of CGTMSE beneficiaries and guarantee approved during last three years is mentioned below:-
