Opening of JNVs

338 Shri Prabhakar Reddy Vemireddy:

Will the Minister of **Education** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Navodaya Vidyalaya Scheme envisages opening one Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya (JNV) in each district of the country;
- (b) whether it has come to the notice of the Ministry that the State Government of Andhra Pradesh has created 13 new districts for administrative convenience;
- (c) the efforts being made by the Ministry to open JNVs in the newly created districts; and
- (d) the details of smart class systems set up in the existing JNVs of Andhra Pradesh?

ANSWER

**MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION
(SMT. ANNPURNA DEVI)**

(a) Yes, Sir. Navodaya Vidyalaya Scheme envisages opening of one Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya (JNV) in each district of the country.

(b) & (c) : Yes, Sir. Opening of new JNVs is a continuous process which depends on the willingness of the concerned State Government/UT administration to make available requisite suitable land free of cost for construction of the permanent building and making available required temporary building, free of rent, to run the Vidyalaya till the permanent building is constructed. However, actual sanction and opening of new JNV depends on the availability of funds and approval by the Competent Authority. All the districts of the States/UTs (as on 31st May, 2014), which have accepted the Navodaya Vidyalaya scheme, have been covered under this scheme. All the existing 13 districts of Andhra Pradesh as on 31st May, 2014 have been covered under the scheme and there are 15 JNVs functional in Andhra Pradesh including 02 additional JNVs at Prakasam district (SC concentrated) & East Godavari district (ST concentrated).

(d) The details of smart class systems set up in the existing JNVs of Andhra Pradesh are annexed.
