NATIONAL CYCLONE RISK MITIGATION PROJECT IN ANDHRA PRADESH

377. SHRI PRABHAKAR REDDY VEMIREDDY:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether National Cyclone Risk Mitigation Project (NCRMP) is being implemented in Andhra Pradesh and other States;
- (b) since when the above project which is World Bank sponsored Centrally Sponsored Scheme is being implemented in Andhra Pradesh; and
- (c) the details of infrastructure being created under NCRMP to reduce damage to property and casualties during cyclones, etc., in the coastal areas of Andhra Pradesh?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI NITYANAND RAI)

(a) to (c): National Cyclone Risk Mitigation Project (NCRMP) is a World Bank assisted Centrally Sponsored Scheme, being implemented in the 8 coastal States, in two phases. Two States were covered in Phase-I, namely, Andhra Pradesh and Odisha; and six States are covered in Phase-II, namely Goa, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra and West Bengal.

Phase-I of NCRMP, in the States of Andhra Pradesh and Odisha, commenced from January, 2011 and was completed in December, 2018.

The details of infrastructure created in the coastal areas of Andhra Pradesh under NCRMP are as under:-

- i) Early Warning Dissemination System (EWDS):
 - a. Sites / Locations (No.): 255
 - b. Alert Sirens (No.): 153
 - c. Digital Mobile Radio Installation (No.): 238
 - d. Satellite Terminal (No.): 20
- ii) Cyclone Risk Mitigation Infrastructure (CRMI Works):
 - a. Multipurpose Cyclone Shelters (No.): 219
 - b. Connecting Roads (KM): 698.02
 - c. Connecting Bridges (No.): 34
 - d. Saline Embankment (KM): 29.90
