(a) to (c) Ministry of Panchayati Raj implemented the scheme of Rashtriya Gram Swaraj Abhiyan (RGSA) from 2018-19 to 2021-22 under which funds were provided to States for strengthening of Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs) by way of capacity building of PRIs and its functionaries, through more use of technology and handholding some Panchayats as peer learning centres. The scheme was demand driven in nature and funds was released to States/UTs on the basis of submission of Annual Proposals and approval thereof by Central Executive Committee (CEC) of RGSA, State may utilize the released amount as per the priority set by the State.

Details of activities including technical assistance for which funds were sanctioned to State of Karnataka during the last year under RGSA is as follows:
