**FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER SWARNJAYANTI GRAM SWAROZGAR
YOJANA (SGSY)**

420 SHRI K.R.N. RAJESHKUMAR:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) total number of persons to whom financial assistance under Swarnjayanti Gram Swarozgar Yojana (SGSY) has been provided in the country particularly in the State of Tamil Nadu during last three years and current year; and
- (b) the details of the funds allocated/released/utilised under the scheme alongwith the total financial assistance given to each State for BPL population?

(a) & (b) The Swarnjayanti Gram Swarozgar Yojana (SGSY) was started in the year 1999 and restructured in Financial Year 2010-11 as the National Rural Livelihoods Mission (Aajeevika) based on the recommendation of Radhakrishna Committee. It was formally launched on 3rd June, 2011 and after a transition period of two years, SGSY ceased to exist with effect from 1st April, 2013. Further, Special Projects under SGSY were also implemented for Placement Linked Skill Development of Rural Youth up-to the year 2012-13. The projects were implemented in two modes, i.e., State Specific Project (SSP) and Multi State Project (MSP). No new project was sanctioned under SGSY after the above mentioned period. So, no financial assistance has been provided to persons under the scheme during the last three years.

The closure procedures for few SGSY Special Project are still continuing. The reimbursement made for the projects implemented during the above mentioned duration under both the modes in last three years and current year is as follows:
