BROADCASTING OF FAKE NEWS

545. SHRI NEERAJ DANGI:

Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING

be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of cases noticed during the last two years related to broadcasting of fake news against India by other countries; and
- (b) the details of the action taken against such TV channels during the said period, country-wise and channel-wise?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): All TV channels, including foreign channels granted permission for downlinking in India, are required to adhere to the Programme Code under the Cable Television Networks (Regulation) Act, 1995, including that programmes should not contain anything obscene, defamatory, false and suggestive innuendos and half-truths. Appropriate action is taken wherever violation of Programme Code is found.
