PENDENCY UNDER RTI ACT, 2005

Will the **PRIME MINISTER** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether thousands of applications under the Right to Information (RTI) Act, 2005 are pending in the country and if so, the details thereof, State-wise including in the State of Karnataka;
- (b) whether Government has made assessment of the reasons for inordinate delay in the disposal of RTI applications;
- (c) if so, the outcome thereof and the remedial measures taken/being taken in this regard;
- (d) whether one can apply online under the RTI Act 2005; and
- (e) if so, the details of the procedure to be followed and the assistance provided to the States for the purpose?

(a): Central Information Commission (CIC) data shows that 26518 appeals/complaints cases are pending with CIC as on 18.07.2022.

However, State-wise data on applications under the RTI Act is maintained by the respective State Governments.

(b) & (c): Does not arise.

(d) & (e): Subject to the provisions of the Act, Indian citizens can file online applications under the Right to Information Act, 2005. Any applicant can visit the portal www.rtionline.gov.in and select the desired Ministry or Department under Central Government and file an Online RTI Application. A detailed user manual and Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) are available on the website to help in filing the application. Applicant can pay the requisite fee through Online Payment in this portal and submit the RTI Application.

All the States had been requested to explore the feasibility of implementing online RTI in their respective States. National Informatics Centre (NIC) has been requested to provide technical support, such as software, and source code to the State Governments which desire to replicate the web portal for online filing of RTI applications at state level.
