**ANIMAL HUSBANDRY INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT FUND (AHIDF)**

752 SHRI ABIR RANJAN BISWAS:

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING  
be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of individual entrepreneurs, private companies, MSME, and Farmers Producers Organisations (FPOs) that have been given funds since the inception of the scheme for dairy processing and value addition infrastructure, meat processing and value addition infrastructure, and Animal Feed Plant, year-wise and State-wise;
- (b) the funds that have been allocated out of the total package of Rs. 15000 crores; and
- (c) the details of the steps Government proposes to take to further increase the coverage of the scheme?

**ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING

(SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)

(a) The number of individual entrepreneurs, private companies, MSME, and Farmers Producers Organizations (FPOs) that have been given funds since the inception of the scheme for dairy processing and value addition infrastructure, meat processing and value addition infrastructure, and Animal Feed Plant, year-wise and State-wise are annexed at annexure I.

(b) Rs 15000 crore is a corpus under which credit facility is being made available for the eligible entities by the scheduled bank, out of which credit Facility of Rs 2734.91 crore has already been disbursed by the scheduled banks.

The funds allocated to the Department are being utilized in various heads as Subsidy (Interest subvention), General head (Credit Guarantee), Professional services, Advertisement and Publicity and office expenses. As far as interest subvention is concerned, funds of Rs. 37.74 crore have been released by the Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying to various beneficiaries and Rs 216.00 crores has been released to credit Guarantee fund.

The details of the budgetary allocation by the Government for Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund (AHIDF) expenditure for those funds are as under:

(c) The Government has taken following steps to increase the coverage of the scheme:

1. For effective implementation and a fair and transparent mechanism, digitalization of scheme through an online portal ahidf.udyamimitra.in is in place.
2. The end-to-end digital journey from application to disbursement of loan and interest subvention is online through ahidf.udyamimitra.in which is user friendly with all necessary documents.
3. Portal is integrated with all India network of common service centers for handholding the applicants from the rural parts of the country.
4. Addition of new categories and activities for Breed Multiplication farm and Breed improvement technology, Manufacturing of milk testing equipments and Dairy equipment, manufacturing of feed supplements/ feed additives, setting up of Veterinary drugs & vaccine units, Animal waste to wealth management to further increase off take from fund.
5. National Dairy Development Board has been added as the hand holding agency on the portal for making free of cost DPR for small entrepreneurs.
6. National Cooperative Development Corporation has been added as the preferred lender on the portal.
7. For preparation of detailed project report model proposals and a directory of handholding agencies is uploaded on the portal.
8. For a better outreach and awareness various audio video aids are being used for propagation of the scheme. The brochures and leaflets for the schemes with the QR code through which the portal will open.
9. Various webinars/workshops etc are being organized for creating awareness for targeted group of people like Dairy associations/ feed associations and Meat associations and various State Governments.
10. Various State level awareness programmes are conducted with various State Governments where Hon'ble Cabinet Minister, Chief Ministers and State Ministers with senior officials are participating for reaching out to the targeted beneficiaries.
11. Online mechanism for monitoring and reviewing is done by Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Department of Financial Services, Credit Guarantee Fund Trust of Animal Husbandry and Dairying and State Governments of scheme on a regular basis.
12. To reach out to the common people the scheme guidelines have been translated into 13 languages.
13. Documentary films have been developed for facilitating the common people to understand the scheme.
14. A Conclave with more than 600 participants was organized where the lenders, States, and Entrepreneurs were felicitated to attract more Entrepreneurs in order to promote scheme.
15. Provision of Dovetailing with the scheme of Ministry of Food Processing Industries (MoFPI), National Livestock Mission and any Central Government and State Government schemes.
