RASHTRIYA YUVA SASHAKTIKARAN KARYAKRAM (RYSK) SCHEME

634 SMT. VANDANA CHAVAN:

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of works done and number of beneficiaries under the Rashtriya Yuva Sashaktikaran Karyakram Scheme (RYSK), State wise;
- (b) the details of the funds allocated, released and spent for RYSK, since last five years, State-wise;
- (c) the number of institutions being provided financial assistance under the Scheme, State-wise; and
- (d) the details of implementation of the RYSK in the State of Maharashtra?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS

(SHRI ANURAG SINGH THAKUR)

(a) The Rashtriya Yuva Sashaktikaran Karyakram (RYSK), Central Sector Scheme, is an umbrella Scheme covering the following seven sub-schemes:

- (i) Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS)
- (ii) National Youth Corps (NYC)
- (iii) National Programme for Youth & Adolescent Development (NPYAD)
- (iv) International Cooperation (IC)
- (v) Youth Hostels (YH)
- (vi) Assistance to Scouting & Guiding Organisations
- (vii) National Young Leaders Programme (NYLP)

The details of work done under RYSK are at **Annexure-I**. The Department of Youth Affairs, through the RYSK, conducts various programmes with the objective to develop personality and leadership qualities of the youth and to engage them in nation-building activities. State/UT-Wise details of number of beneficiaries/participants are at **Annexure-II**.

(b) Under the RYSK, funds are allocated for the country as a whole (not state-wise). The details of funds allocated and expenditure during 2017-18 to 2021-22 are at **Annexure-III**.

(c) Under the NPYAD, a component of RYSK Scheme, financial assistance is provided to Government/ non-Government organisations for taking up activities for youth and adolescent development. Details of number of institutions who have been provided financial assistance, state-wise, during 2017-18 to 2021-22 are at **Annexure-IV**.

(d) The Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports runs various schemes for development of Youth in the country as a whole including in the state of Maharashtra. The details of activities carried out under the RYSK in the state are (i) NYC, 647 Volunteers are deployed (ii) One Youth Hostel is functional in Aurangabad (iii) Under NYLP, Neighborhood Youth Parliament was conducted with 7734 participants (iv) The details of activities carried out by NYKS are at **Annexure-V**.

ANNEXURE REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PART (a) OF THE RAJYA SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO.634 FOR 21.07.2022ASKED BY SMT. VANDANA CHAVAN REGARDING RASHTRIYA YUVA SASHAKTIKARAN KARYAKRAM (RYSK) SCHEME

1 Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS): The Programmes/ Activities of NYKS broadly fall in the following categories:

- a. Core Programmes: These include Training on Youth Leadership and Community Development, Theme-based Awareness and Education Programme, Promotion of Sports, Skill Up-gradation Training Programme, District Youth Convention and Yuva Kriti, etc.
- b. Programmes organised with funding from NPYAD: These include National Integration Camps (NICs), Youth Leadership and Personality Development Programmes (YLPDPs), Life Skill Training Programmes and Adventure Camps.
- c. Programmes organised with funding from other Ministries/ Organisations: These include Tribal Youth Exchange Programmes, Adolescent Health and Development Project (AHDP), Projects on Awareness and Education for Prevention of Drug Abuse and Alcoholism in Punjab, etc.
- d. Programmes in coordination with various Departments/ Agencies: NYKS does not receive any funding, but organizes/ participates in various programmes in coordination with various Development Departments/ Agencies. Some such activities are blood donation, plantation of saplings, organization of health/ eye/ immunization camps, enrolment of children in schools, etc.

2 National Youth Corps (NYC): youth in the age-group of 18-29 years are engaged as volunteers to serve upto maximum 2 years in nation-building activities. They act as an extended arm of NYKS in the Block and play an active role in implementation of various programmes and initiatives of NYKS through youth clubs.

3 National Programme for Youth and Adolescent Development (NPYAD): Financial assistance is provided to Government/ non-Government organisations for taking up activities for youth and adolescent development. The assistance under NPYAD is provided under 5 major components, namely, Youth Leadership and Personality Development Training, Promotion of National Integration (National Integration Camps, Inter-State Youth Exchange Programmes, Youth Festivals, multi-cultural activities, etc.), Promotion of Adventure; Tenzing Norgay National Adventure Awards, Development and Empowerment of Adolescents (Life Skills Education, Counselling, Career Guidance, etc.) and Technical and Resource Development (Research and Studies on Youth issues, Documentation, Seminars/ Workshops)

4 International Cooperation: Exchange of Youth Delegations with friendly countries is taken up for promoting exchange of ideas, values and culture amongst the youth of different countries and also to promote peace and understanding. It helps in developing international perspective among the youth.

5 Youth Hostels: Youth Hostels are built to promote youth travel within the country with low cost, budget accommodation and facilities to travelling students and youth groups on excursions or study tours. The aim of the scheme is to encourage youth travel to know more about the diversity of India's culture and people. Youth Hostels are generally established, in locations of historical, cultural and tourist interest and significance.

6 Assistance to Scouting and Guiding Organizations: The Department provides assistance to the Scouting and Guiding Organizations, with a view to promote the Scouts and Guides movement in the country which seeks to promote balanced physical and mental development among the boys and girls through training camps, skill development programmes, holding of jamborees, etc.

7 National Young Leaders Programme (NYLP): NYLP is a Scheme introduced during 2014-15. The Objective of the Scheme is to develop leadership qualities among the youth to enable them to realize their full potential and in the process, to contribute to the nation-building process.

iii. Under the IC component of RYSK, due to CoVID-19, only four Youth were sent abroad during 2021-22.

iv. Under the Scouting & Guiding component of RYSK, funds are released only to National Headquarters of Scouting & Guiding organisations (i.e Bharat Scouts & Guides, Hindustan Scouts & Guides).

v. Under the Youth Hostel component of RYSK funds are only released as Honorarium to Managers of Youth Hostel and for repair and renovation of Youth Hostel.
