EFFECTS OF NAVAL EXERCISES ON LIVELIHOODS OF FISHERMEN

847. SHRI VENKATARAMANA RAO MOPIDEVI: SHRI SUBHAS CHANDRA BOSE PILLI:

Will the Minister of Defence be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is aware that restrictions imposed on fishing during naval exercises and events adversely affect the livelihood of the fishermen;
- (b) if so, the steps taken to compensate them for the loss; and
- (c) the measures taken to provide alternate location to the fishermen after the ban on sale of fish at the harbor?

ANSWER

- (a): No restrictions are imposed on fishing/ fish trading by the fishing communities during the conduct of naval exercise/ events.
- (b): Question of compensation does not arise as no restrictions are imposed on fishing/ fish trading/ sale of fish by the fishing communities during naval exercises.
- (c): No Ban is imposed on sale of fish in harbor by the Indian Navy.
