Ayushman Bharat–Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) is an entitlement-based scheme. Eligible beneficiaries can directly visit any empanelled public or private hospital to avail cashless treatment. Ayushman cards are issued to the beneficiaries to create awareness about the scheme. As of 21st July 2022, a total of 18.54 crore Ayushman Bharat cards have been issued under the Ayushman Bharat-Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY).

State/UT-wise details of number of authorized hospital admissions are at Annexure.

The benefits under the scheme includes all expenses incurred on the following components of the treatment:

- Medical examination, treatment and consultation
- Pre-hospitalization up to 3 days
- Medicine and medical consumables
- Non-intensive and intensive care services
- Diagnostic and laboratory investigations
- Medical implantation services (where necessary)
- Accommodation benefits
- Food services
- Post-hospitalization follow-up care up to 15 days

States/UT of Odisha, West Bengal and Delhi are not implementing AB-PMJAY presently.
