Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the priorities set by Government of India's G20 Presidency;
- (b) whether Government has any plans to utilize the G20 platform to formulate a robust strategy for a resilient recovery of global economic growth and recalibrate the action plan for achieving 2030 Sustainable Development Goals agenda;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether Government has any plans to use India's G20 presidency to champion the cause of developing nations in coping with the climate crisis; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) to (c) Some of the substantive deliberations in broad priority areas during our G20 Presidency inter alia revolve around inclusive and resilient growth; progress on SDGs; green development and LiFE; technological transformation and public digital infrastructure; reforming multilateral institutions; women led development; and international peace and harmony. Outcomes in these areas would emerge out of the deliberations during the course of our G20 Presidency.
