(a) to (d): Government of India launched Smart Cities Mission (SCM) on 25 June 2015. 100 Smart Cities have been selected through 4 rounds of competition from January 2016 to June 2018. 6 cities were selected for development as Smart Cities in the State of Gujarat. As on 2 December 2022, the status of funds utilized and project implementation in Smart Cities of Gujarat are as given below:-
