Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of rural houses in the States of Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, and Odisha which have been targeted to supply tap water under 'Nal Se Jal Yojana'; and
- (b) the number of houses which have been provided with this facility at present against the set target and by when the remaining part of the scheme is expected to be completed and the amount of financial expenditure to be incurred by Government for this?

(a) & (b) Since August 2019, Government of India in partnership with States is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) – Har Ghar Jal to make provision of potable water to every rural household of the country by 2024 including those in Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand and Odisha, through tap water connection. Details of rural households and households with tap water connections in these States is as under:
