Will the Minister of Defence be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is planning to expand the acquisition of hospitals and health centers under ECHS;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, especially in the State of Uttarakhand;
- (c) whether the pending acquisition of polyclinics under the scheme has been completed; and
- (d) if so, the district-wise details of the number of polyclinics acquired in the FY 2021-22?

ANSWER

- (a): The empanelment of Health Care Organisations (HCOs) is a continuous process, depending upon requirement and availability of National Accreditation Board for Hospitals & Healthcare (NABH) and Quality Council of India (QCI) accreditation of HCOs for empanelment.
- (b): 43 Hospitals including Bombay Hospital & Research Centre, Krishan Hospital & Research Centre, Kailash Hospital, Max Health Care and Metro Hospital & Heart Institutes etc. are empanelled in the State of Uttarakhand. The following new buildings of existing Polyclinics are under process of construction in the State of Uttarakhand:
 - i. Vikasnagar Type D
 - ii. Raiwala Type C
- iii. Pauri Garhwal Type C
- (c): The scheme has 427 Polyclinics functioning across the country. New Hospitals and other HCOs are considered for empanelment as a continuous process, depending upon requirement and availability of NABH and QCI accreditation of HCOs for empanelment.
