**BENEFICIARY UNDER 'HAR GHAR NAL SE JAL' YOJANA**

1364. SHRI PRAKASH JAVADEKAR:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of families who have got benefit of tap connections under Har Ghar Nal Se Jal Yojana scheme in the State of Kerala;
- (b) the number of connections sanctioned in Kerala; and
- (c) the number of beneficiaries in Kerala, District-wise?

**ANSWER**

- (a) Government of India in partnership with States is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM)-Har Ghar Jal to make provision of tap water supply to every rural household of the country including those of Kerala by 2024. As reported by Kerala, since the launch of Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) in August 2019, 15.24 lakh (28.21%) households have been provided with tap water connections in the state.
- (b) As reported by Kerala, 53.35 lakhs households tap connections have been sanctioned under JJM in the state.
- (c) The district-wise number of households/beneficiaries provided with tap water connection under JJM in Kerala (as on 14.12.2022) is given at **Annex-I**.
