Resumption of work in Rajhara colliery

1405. SHRI SAMIR ORAON:

Will the Minister of Coal be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Rajhara colliery at Palamu, Jharkhand has got a coal reserve;
- (b) whether it is also a fact that no mining activity has been undertaken since last 14 years despite having the said reserves;
- (c) whether mining work was halted over there, subsequent to water ingress taking place in the mine, during the year 2008; and
- (d) if so, the plans being made by Government to resume mining work in such closed mines, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS, COAL AND MINES (SHRI PRALHAD JOSHI)

- (a): Yes, Sir.
- (b) & (c): Due to imposition of statutory order by DGMS, all mining operations, except pumping operation, were suspended between between 24.10.2010 to 17.12.2020 after ingress of water.
- (d): At present, mining work at Rajhara colliery has resumed and overburden is being removed. CIL has identified following closed/discontinued/abandoned coal mines for reopening on revenue sharing basis:
